"I am very pleased to have this vote of confidence from the Board of VES and am proud to represent our members to the film, television, gaming and entertainment community.

"Under Eric's leadership the VES has grown into an internationally respected organization that has become the 'go-to' source for anything visual effects. Up next for Roth and VES is the organization's annual VES Awards program. Scheduled for February 1, this year's program will honor Christopher Nolan with the inaugural VES Visionary Award and Ray Harryhausen with the VES Lifetime Achievement Award.
