- 3:04 – What is the greatest challenge of making a show like this? Gregg says a lot of it hinges on the visual effects and points out the challenge of introducing five new characters to the Marvel universe.
- 4:10 – On the great ensemble that's built up around the core cast. Says he's geeking out about working with Adama (Edward James Olmos) on a daily basis.
- 04:38 – The show took time to find its footing, but the numbers are getting better and better.
- 05:52 – When did Gregg find out the Inhumans were going to be part of the show?
- 06:41 – On not knowing if he'll return to the Marvel Cinematic Universe; he'd be surprised if Marvel didn't seize the opportunity for its shows and movies to connect.
- 08:02 – His lighter workload and the opportunity to pursue additional projects; a new movie he's writing.
- 08:52 – Going from not being needed for the Iron Man Comic-Con panel to getting free drinks at SDCC.
