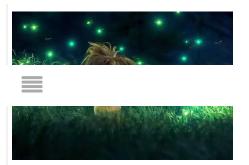


Star Wars: The Force Awakens and Game Of Thrones came in to the 14th annual VES Awards with the most nominations, and they left with the most wins: four apiece. The Revenant went home with three statuettes. The trophies were handed out at the Beverly Hilton, hosted Patton Oswalt, who delivered a hilarious opening monologue and kept proceedings fast and light, and occasionally profane - for instance near the end, when he implored *Batman* v Superman director Zach Snyder not to F— up the film and franchise.

Let's start by addressing the exogorth in the room: *Star Wars: The Force Awakens* came in with a seven nominations and won the big award by beating fellow VFX Oscar nominees *Mad Max: Fury Road* and *The Martian* as well as *Furious 7* and *San Andreas.* The winners of VES' top film award has gone on to score the Visual Effects Oscar nine out of 14 times.
